Jerry's Hanger – January, 2008

Rookie races: The racing poles have been moved out further away from the runway and closer together. The pylons are now 450 feet apart. The previous poles were around 525 feet and race times should be shortened. New race times and records will be based on the new locations for this new year. When flying using a 2.4GHz frequency, STRCC members are still required to get a frequency pin. Your AMA membership card is placed in the location of the frequency pin which you pick up.

It was noted that the possibility of flying past the levy might be possible with large scale aircraft. All STRCC members should be aware of where the levy is and try and keep their aircraft on the same side as the runway. We do not want to fly over the landfill area. This is especially true when the landfill is open and workers are present.

Noise was also discussed at the meeting. I do not know of any fliers running engines without mufflers. If you have a noisy powerplant / propeller, please come up with a solution to keep your plane quiet.

Fliers also need to communicate with each other when getting ready to fly or during flying. If you are going out to the runway, announce to fliers that you are entering the runway. Likewise, if you are landing let all know your intentions. If you loose power to your engine, announce "DEAD STICK". As always, communicate with all when you fire up that 13-14K spinning propeller. Another example for letting others know when you are flying a non-standard left hand pattern.

Helicopters and planes need to coordinate with each other at the field. I don't think this happens very often, but the patterns of the aircraft need to be coordinated. We do have a pad on the north side of the park as such, it should be used if planes are at the field and are using the runway and airspace.
